In a recent survey, 30% of non-Christians and 10% of Christians thought the church was 'not compatible with science.' *How do we respond to that?*

The Faraday Institute is named after the outstanding scientist **Michael Faraday**, who invented the electric motor and was Professor of Chemistry at the Royal Institution. He was famous for his public lectures, as well as preaching in his local Church, and saw no conflict between his research and his Christian faith.

Our aim is to continue in the footsteps of Michael Faraday, encouraging and equipping UK churches to engage with science as part of their regular ministry and mission.

The Faraday Institute carries out both academic research and communication with the general public. We are based in the grounds of Westminster College, Cambridge, and an Associate Member of the Cambridge Theological Federation.

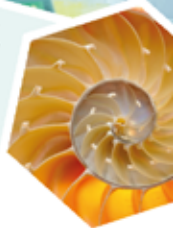
